

TriMark Celebrates Ribbon Cutting Ceremony in Quincy, Illinois

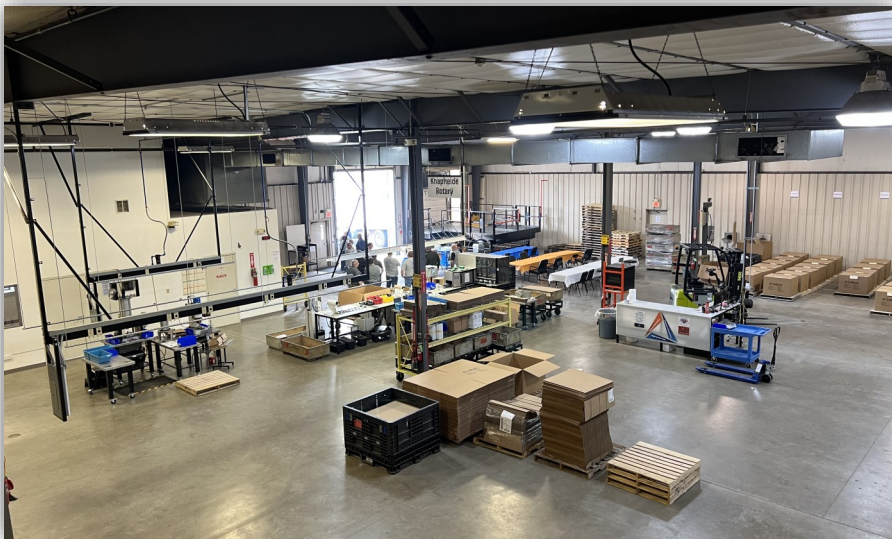
